Summary of findings:

Since receiving the grant in February 2023, my collaborator and I have been able to substantially develop our theory of a feminist legal geography of home. In that period, we went from ideas on a page to a fully worked paper that has now been presented in three different international conferences and one version will be published. To us, this represents significant progress, and has also opened up new paths for research and also new opportunities for collaboration.

Plans for continuing collaboration:

Professor Clough and I will most certainly continue our collaboration. In fact, we feel we are only at the beginning! The Charlemont funding enabled us to make an energetic start to what we hope will be a long-term partnership of ideas, writing and activism.

Publications associated with this project that you have been involved in:

The first version of our paper has been invited to be part of a bid for a special issue of *Geoforum*, which is a leading human geography journal. This special issue came out of the conference presentation I did at the Royal Geographic Society annual conference in London at the end of August. This is significant for us as law scholars to be publishing in a leading geography journal.

The second version of our paper we intend to submit to a generalist law journal in early 2024.

Finally, we are writing a book proposal for the Routledge series 'New Trajectories in Law', which has been initially accepted by the publisher.
