### (1) Genealogical snippet on Clann Uí Mhaoil Chonaire in Bks of Lecan and Ballymote

### (5) Note by Dubhaltach Mac Fhir Bhisigh on Clann Uí Mhaoil Chonaire as historians

**LGen. 5.4**: [Some of the historians, together with the territories and the leading kindreds for whom they speak in the latter times]:

Oi Mhaolchonaire ag Siol Muireadhoigh um Chruachain, drong diobh i tTuaghmumuin, agus araile i Laighnibh agus isin Anghaile dhibh.

### (6) Ó Maoil Chonaire in Census of Ireland, 1901

Surname anglicised **Conry** and – only in Clare – **Mulconry**; also **Conroy**, usually a different, more numerous, surname – it is now almost impossible to disentangle the two. (Few non-anglicised forms of Irish surnames occur in Census of 1901; a small number in that of 1911.)

The Census of Ireland 1901 has 634 instances of **Conry** (compared to 38 of **Mulconry** – and 3,978 of **Conroy**). Of those 634 examples, 596 occur in six counties: **Roscommon 271**, Mayo 162, Galway 83, Sligo 33, Clare 25 and Dublin 22.

### (7) Places in Co. Roscommon with which Clann Uí Mhaoil Chonaire was associated

**Baile Uí Mhaoil Chonaire** (Ballymulconry) – now obsolete – appears to have represented 4 townlands in civil parish of Kiltrustran: **Mihanagh, Creta, Lisduff** and **Grange**, ‘and some further parcels’ [Paul Walsh, *IML*, 47]; total area: 734+ acres. Seems to have had an alternative name, now also obsolete: **Cluain Plocáin**, or **Cluain Bolgáin** (see *IML* 46).

Less than 2 km north of Cluain Plocáin lies townland of **Cloonahee (Cluain na hOidhche [>Oíche])** in parish of Clooncraff – another important Ó Maoil Chonaire base.

All these are in NE Roscommon ‘lakeland’, 5 to 8 km E of Elphin, and same distance N of Strokestown, while Cloonahee also lies about 10 km S of Carrick-on-Shannon.

About 7 km NE of Cloonahee (and about 9 km SE of Carrick-on-Shannon) is townland of **Baile an Choimín** (anglicised Ballycummin) in par. of Kilmore. On shore of Lough Boderg, a lake through which the Shannon flows – midway between Lough Allen to N and Lough Ree to S. Immediately N of Ballycummin is double townland of Clooncommon, Beg and More (117 and 330 acres, respectively) – 124 acres in Ballycummin. Unlike Ballycummin, Clooncommon does not appear to be on record prior to the 1830s.
